Afterwards it stepped into imperially Austrian ones service in the army and became a captain. The year for the appointment, 1780, specified in the 1st edition, was already because of the age of 21 years improbable. It died unmarried.

Johann Ludwig ninth son, born 21 January 1770, died. 24 January 1861 to Nippes with Cologne. It stood 1789 as Leutnant in cure-Palatinate services.

It Clemens August Maria Nepomuk became under 27 of its brother. March 1794 of the manorial estate counsellor transfer, whom he sold later.

From counsellor it sent on 20 June 1829 its coat-of-arms to royally the government to Koblenz, in behalf of to admission into the aristocracy register the Prussian Rhein country which can be put on again.

In an Internet site for the history of the contactor company of counsellor and Vennikel the following is implemented: "Theodor Giesberts has in former times (in fixed Buch to the contactor celebration of 1973 and at last in: Lives in Traar, Haus- and Heimatbuch, 1991, page 272 FF.) already reported that it discovered parish church of Traar two documents in archives that catholic, which to the origins of the contactor nature in Traar refer. On the oldest document of 3rd August 1812 baron Friedrich August gives von Kleist, owners of the castle counsellor, one "specifications over the contactor silver".

Afterwards 1810 without the bird of 63 pieces of silver were present. From it baron Kleist removed

altogether 27 pieces at that time, around for it on request of the contactor company of two new brother Meister staffs make to let..."

It was twice married:

a)with Maria Anna of Felicitas Freiin v. Leerodt on Leerodt, former bishopric lady of the Damen bishopric Diethkirchen in Bonn, daughter of Johann Jakob Joseph Anton baron v. L. and Maria Odilia v. Satzenhoven and Perchtelshoven, born 7/10/1761, married 1793. It died to 30. 4. 1823 in house counsellor.

On the five children of this marriage 1850 lived only a daughter: Carolina Justina, baptized 23 January 1796 in Bockum, Stiftsdame to Dietkirchen, afterwards to Ronsdorf at König winter, later on Kleist height, their possession with Sesten nearby Bonn, died. 30. August 1878 in Bonn.
